Musicians shouldn't have to navigate the music industry alone—it was challenging enough before the pandemic made things even harder for performers. And in this age of music streaming, record labels are not investing in artist development the way they used to.

This is where we come in. WXPN has a long-standing national reputation as a musical tastemaker and is uniquely situated in the landscape as a leading public radio music station with the influence and connections to make a real impact. So we're meeting the moment by deepening our support for emerging artists in the ways they need most—air play; digital engagement; financial resources; mentorship; local partnerships; and opportunities to perform live. To put it simply, we're doing what we do best, connecting artists and audiences in new and expanding ways.

ARTIST TO WATCH

Monthly for the last two decades, WXPN Programming staff identifies an emerging artist creating exciting and compelling work and puts the full force of WXPN's platform behind them, spotlighting the artist through a combination of on-air promotion and online features to help audiences deepen their discovery.

As the Covid pandemic waned, a new kind of music industry emerged. One which compelled WXPN to commit to growing our impact on new and emerging artists here and across the country. So in 2023, we took it up a notch with a first of its kind Artist Residency program, highlighting the work of six Black Americana performers. Based on that success, annual residencies for emerging talents will become a keystone of our Artist to Watch program.

Robust editorial content through XPN Local (formerly known as The Key) is available digitally on XPN.org and via social media. Black Music City, our partnership with WRTI and REC Philly which makes grants directly to Black creatives working in Philadelphia, is currently in its 4th year. Additionally XPN has partnered with Philly Music Fest to offer biannual local music industry info and networking gatherings.

The WXPN team has its finger on the pulse of Philadelphia and the surrounding region's music scene, and consistently endeavors to bring talented performers to the forefront.
